- 1) I understand that it is the Subcontractor's responsibility to inform their employees of the policies and procedures set forth in A&M Construction's Safety Overview for Contractor Personnel and OSHA 29 CFR 1926, Construction Industry Regulations.*
- 2) I understand that the Subcontractor's employees and all those who work for the Subcontractor under contract with A&M Construction Co., Inc. are required to be in compliance with OSHA 29 CFR 1926, A&M Construction Co., Inc.'s safety policies and procedures and the Owner's safety policy and procedures at all times when on a job site.*
- 3) I understand that noncompliance by any Subcontractor employee or those who work for the Subcontractor under contract with A&M Construction Co., Inc. is cause for action that can include removal from the job site. Any costs associated with such removal will be incurred by the Subcontractor.*
- 4) I understand that Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for hazardous products used in the Subcontractor's Scope of Work must accompany the material to the job site and a copy sent to A&M Construction Co., Inc.'s main office in Wakefield, MA.*
